Stony Brook is on the “Port Jefferson” branch.

You will need to change trains at Jamaica and/or Huntington. Ask the conductor.

### Fare Information:

If you arrive on a **Sunday**, you can pay the lower priced “**Off-peak**” Fare.

The details are below.

Purchase your ticket before you get on the train.

You can purchase on the train for a \$6.50 penalty.

You do NOT need to validate your ticket before you get on the train;  
the conductor will punch the ticket on the train.

**Peak fares** are charged during business rush hours on any weekday train scheduled to arrive in NYC terminals between 6 a.m. and 10 a.m. or depart NYC terminals between 4 p.m. and 8 p.m.

**Off-peak fares** are charged all other times on weekdays, all day Saturday and Sunday, and on holidays.

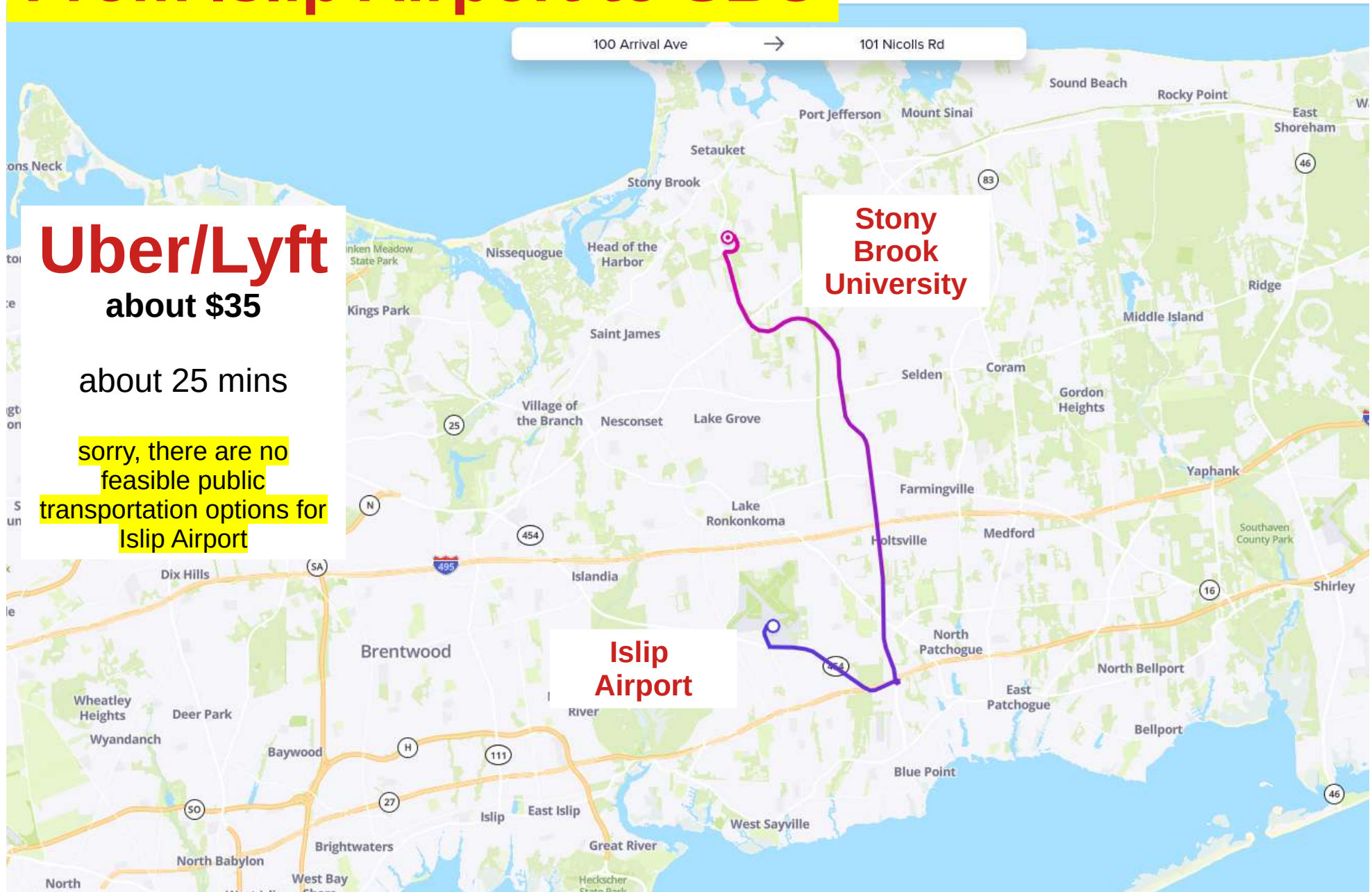
